Courtyard area outside centre presents low risk when coaches arrive/depart. (see note 1)

Centre boundaries are clearly defined. (see note 1)

Yes, specific risk assessment is held to cover all coach routes used in the programme. Low risk. (see note 1)

Yes.

An introductory site tour highlights all relevant hazards to the guests. These hazards are constantly monitored while guests are on site. As a result of this control measure, the risk level is low in all areas noted.
