Access to centre main entrance, guests warned, staff monitor, low risk. (see note 1)

Are the out-of-bounds areas appropriately identified? If so, detail.

Centre boundaries are clearly defined. (see note 1)

Are there any integral transport issues evident from the risk assessment programme?

Yes, specific risk assessment is held to cover all coach routes used in the programme. Low risk.
