## Fire

### Certificate held?

Periodic inspections by Commission de Sécurité.

## Security

### Rooms lockable?

Chalets, yes. Not all dormitories are lockable but Leaders' rooms are. N/A for tents.

### External doors locked at night?

Not in the farmhouse but regular patrols are carried out by night security.

### Night security patrol.

Yes.

### Every adult to wear identity pass at all times?

Yes. (see note 1)

### Control measures ensure adequate lighting of all walkways after dark?

Yes.

Cleaning teams to use warning signs during cleaning.

Yes, via HQ property dept.

Delivery lorries to kitchen. Guests made aware of route on arrival. Care taken with right-hand drive traffic. (see note 1)

Centre boundaries are clearly defined. (see note 1)

## Transport

### Are there any integral transport issues evident from the risk assessment programme?

Yes, specific risk assessment is held to cover all coach routes used in the programme - low risk.
